If the client workstation is configured to a regional language setting that FortiClient Standalone does not support, it defaults to English.

No support for multi-user sessions

FortiClient Standalone does not support multi-user sessions using terminal servers, multi-session OSes, or via user switch.

Intune product code

Deploying FortiClient with Intune requires a product code. The product code for FortiClient Standalone 7.4.7 is BACE1C99-E735-4BBB-B7F6-8D7BE77E162D. See [Configuring the FortiClient application in Intune](#).

Known issues

The following issues have been identified in FortiClient Standalone 7.4.7.

Windows

Bug ID	Description
1290262	When you try installing FortiClient Standalone 7.4.7 on ARM64 Windows, the error message asks to use the ARM64 FortiClient Standalone installer, which does not exist as FortiClient Standalone 7.4.7 does not support ARM64.

macOS

Bug ID	Description
1287235	Local LAN traffic goes through the VPN tunnel even when <i>Enable Local LAN</i> is enabled.
