## Introduction

FortiPhish is a phishing simulation service to analyze how internal users interact with phishing emails. Use FortiPhish to create custom phishing email campaigns and monitor how users respond to them. The FortiPhish portal contains dashboards with easy-to-read data analysis monitors to view responses across campaigns, and monitor improvements over time.

## What's new

The following table lists new features in FortiPhish version 24.4.0.

Feature	Description
Dashboard	<p><i>FortiPhish Dashboard</i> now includes two new widgets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>High Risk Users</i>: Displays a list of users who have consistently exhibited high-risk behavior across all time periods.</li><li>• <i>High Risk Groups</i>: Displays a list of user groups who have consistently exhibited high-risk behavior across all time periods.</li></ul>
Default Risk Grade	The default risk grade for users not performing any action has been changed from <i>F</i> to <i>B</i> . Previous campaign ratings remain unaffected.

**Note:** Azure AD sync now only supports *Weekly* or *Monthly* sync schedules. *Daily* sync is no longer supported and existing daily schedules will be automatically migrated to *Weekly*.

## Known issues

Issue ID	Description
1089341	Test emails are incorrectly sent using the default server, even when a custom SMTP server is configured.
1081459	Cannot edit the custom landing page title without uploading a zip file.
1105377	Modifying the Azure client sync type to <i>Sync Users and Groups</i> during an active Azure AD sync may cause an internal error.

## Resolved issues

Issue ID	Description
1088864	Azure AD sync incorrectly deletes existing users and groups before syncing new data.
1080830	A conflict occurs when editing a group member's email address to match an email already assigned to a different group, resulting in an internal server error.
1092472	Domain verification may fail if multiple MX records are present, and one of them is invalid.
1081457	Cancelling an SMTP edit requires a page refresh or navigation to another menu to display existing SMTP.
1104158	After editing groups, the group list page may not reflect the changes until the page is refreshed.
