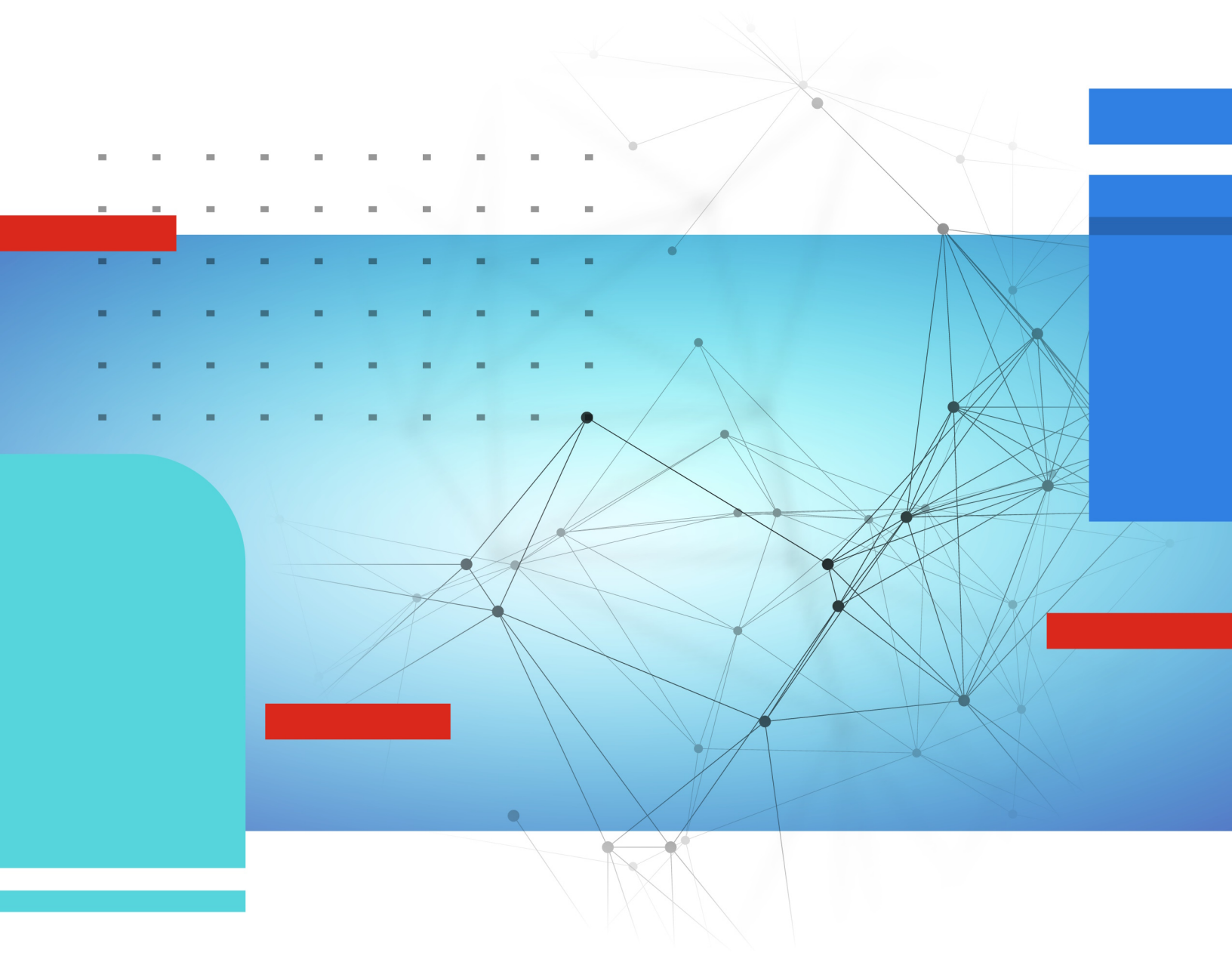

FortiSOAR 7.4.5 Release

Fortinet Security Orchestration, Automation, and Response Platform (FortiSOAR™) release 7.4.5 contains some important usability and security fixes to ensure vulnerabilities are fixed in FortiSOAR. It is highly recommended to upgrade FortiSOAR 7.4.3 or 7.4.4 instances to the 7.4.5 release.

New Features and Enhancements

Release 7.4.5 does not introduce any new features or enhancements; instead, it focuses on addressing critical security and usability issues.

Special Notices

This section highlights some of the operational changes that administrators should be aware of in FortiSOAR release 7.4.5.

FortiSOAR release 7.4.5 is an upgrade-only release

You can only upgrade to FortiSOAR release 7.4.5 from FortiSOAR releases 7.4.3 or 7.4.4. Fresh installation is not supported for this release. It is highly recommended to upgrade existing FortiSOAR 7.4.3 and 7.4.4 instances to the 7.4.5 release as it includes important usability and security fixes.

Upgrade Information

You can upgrade your FortiSOAR enterprise instance, High Availability (HA) cluster, or a distributed multi-tenant configuration to version 7.4.5 from version 7.4.3 or 7.4.4 only. Also, once you have upgraded your configuration, you must log out from the FortiSOAR UI and log back into FortiSOAR.



Upgrading the FortiSOAR Docker image to the 7.4.5 or 7.4.4 releases is not supported.

Also, note that the upgrade procedure temporarily takes the FortiSOAR application offline while the upgrade operations are taking place. We recommend that you send a prior notification to all users of a scheduled upgrade as users are unable to log into the FortiSOAR Platform during the upgrade.

- The recommended minimum screen resolution for the FortiSOAR GUI is 1920 x 1080. Please adjust the screen resolution accordingly. Otherwise, the GUI might not get properly displayed.

For any other virtualization or cloud hosting environment, you can install Rocky Linux 8.7 or RHEL 8.7, and then install FortiSOAR using CLI. For more information, see the "Deployment Guide."
