FortiSOAR 7.5.1 Release

Fortinet Security Orchestration, Automation, and Response Platform (FortiSOAR™) release 7.5.1 contains some important usability and security fixes to ensure vulnerabilities are fixed in FortiSOAR. It is highly recommended to upgrade FortiSOAR 7.5.0 instances to the 7.5.1 release.

New Features and Enhancements

FortiSOAR release 7.5.1 includes important usability and security fixes but does not introduce new features or significant enhancements. We recommend that users currently on release 7.5.0 upgrade to release 7.5.1 or later to benefit from these fixes.

Special Notices

This section highlights some of the operational changes that administrators should be aware of in FortiSOAR release 7.5.1.

FortiSOAR release 7.5.1 is an upgrade-only release

You can only upgrade to FortiSOAR release 7.5.1 from only FortiSOAR release 7.5.0. Fresh installation is not supported for this release. It is highly recommended to upgrade existing FortiSOAR 7.5.0 instances to the 7.5.1 release as it includes important usability and security fixes.

Upgrade Information

You can upgrade your FortiSOAR enterprise instance, High Availability (HA) cluster, or a distributed multi-tenant configuration to version 7.5.1 from version 7.5.0 only. Also, once you have upgraded your configuration, you must log out from the FortiSOAR UI and log back into FortiSOAR.

Also, note that the upgrade procedure temporarily takes the FortiSOAR application offline while the upgrade operations are taking place. We recommend that you send a prior notification to all users of a scheduled upgrade as users are unable to log into the FortiSOAR Platform during the upgrade..

- The recommended minimum screen resolution for the FortiSOAR GUI is 1920 x 1080. Please adjust the screen resolution accordingly. Otherwise, the GUI might not get properly displayed.

FortiSOAR UI Fixes

Bug ID	Description
1063425	Fixed the issue with the <code>Data Archival Search</code> page (Settings > Data Archival > Archival Search) displaying a blank page instead of showing details of the archived data.

Other Fixes

Bug ID	Description
1008243	Fixed the browser storage issue related to large metadata and its copies. This release included optimized browser storage usage for efficient management of model metadata.
1051955	Fixed the issue of accent characters being modified to special characters across FortiSOAR.
1060002	Fixed the issue of incorrect results when calculating the median or other aggregation operations in an ownable module with multiple teams.
1066053	Fixed the issue of SAML single sign-out (SLO) not logging out of the Identity Provider (IdP) after logging out of FortiSOAR.
1070275	Fixed the issue where RBAC was not being honored when exporting all records across all pages from FortiSOAR in CSV format.
