- FON-380
- FON-480

The FortiVoice phone system requires version 6.0.6, 6.4.0 or later to support FortiFone FON-480.

The FortiVoice phone system requires version 6.0.6, 6.4.1 or later to support FortiFone FON-380.

Upgrade information

To upgrade to FortiFone IP phone version 3.0.3 build 134, perform the following procedures:

Download the firmware image file

- 1. Go to the Fortinet Customer Service & Support website.
- 2. Log in to your existing account or register for an account.
- 3. Select Download > Firmware Images.
- 4. In Select Product, select FortiFone.
- 5. Click the **Download** tab.
- 6. Locate the firmware image file that you need to download.
- 7. To download the image file, go to the end of the row and click HTTPS.
- 8. Select to save the file and click OK.
- **9.** Take note of the location where you saved the firmware image file on your computer.

FortiFone IP phone version 3.0.3, build 134 introduces the following changes in the GUI behavior, new features, and enhancements.

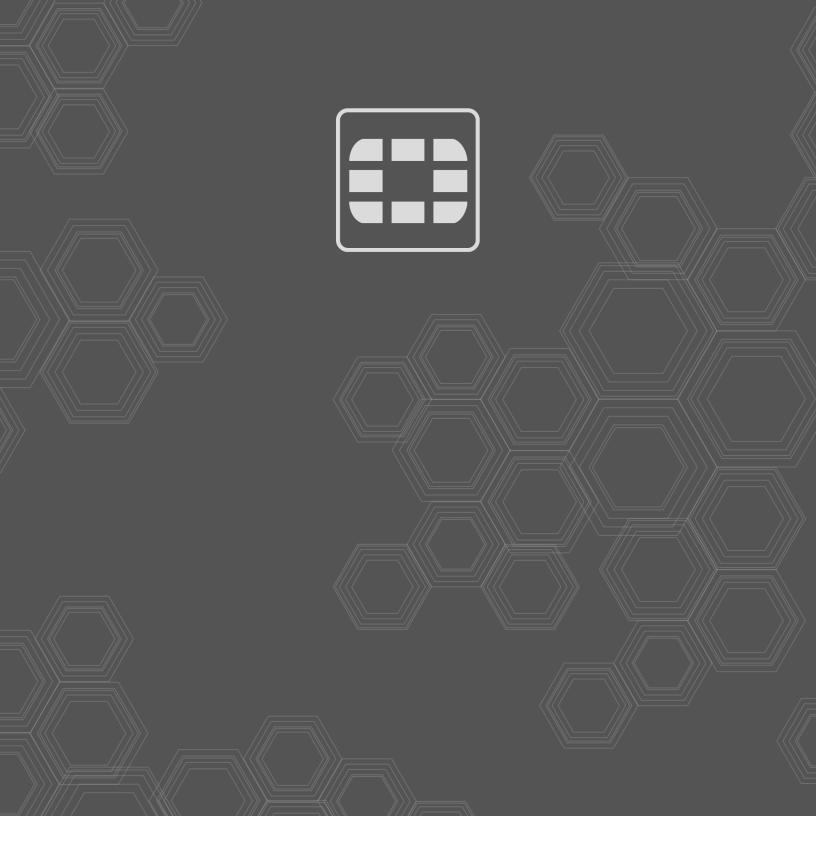

Bug ID	Description
7968	Subscriptions need to re-subscribe if they fail.
7971	Entered characters are not visible in Contact > Search .
7972	Both line keys will indicate if DND mode is enabled.
7978	Redial dials incorrect number if previous outgoing call was transferred by callee to a third party.
8032	Process crash handling enables/disables Electronic Hook Switch (EHS).
673933	Personal contacts do not refresh periodically after starting the phone.
