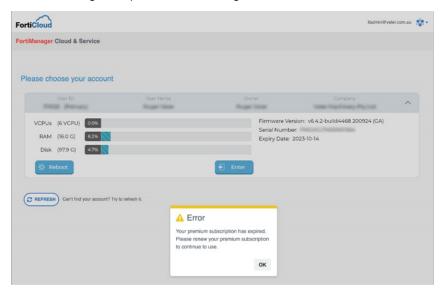
## **Special Notices**

This section highlights some of the operational changes that administrators should be aware of in 6.4.3.

### **FortiCloud Premium license**

The FortiManager Cloud portal checks for a FortiCloud Premium license. If the FortiManager Cloud Cloud license is valid, but the FortiCloud Premium license is expired, a warning is displayed. To access the portal, renew the FortiCloud Premium license.

In the following example, the FortiManager Cloud instance exists, but the license has expired.



## **Upgrade Information**

You can upgrade FortiManager Cloud firmware to 6.4.3 by using the GUI.

### To upgrade firmware:

- 1. In FortiManager Cloud, go to System Settings > Dashboard.
- 2. In the *System Information* widget, go to the *Firmware Version* field, and click the *Upgrade Firmware* icon. The *Firmware Management* dialog box is displayed.
- 3. In the Select Firmware list, select the target version for the upgrade, and click OK. For example, select 6.4.3 to upgrade to 6.4.3.
  The Confirm Upgrade dialog box is displayed.
- 4. Click OK.
  - When the upgrade completes, a message confirms a successful upgrade.
- 5. When the login window displays, log in to FortiManager Cloud.



When the upgrade completes, you might have to refresh your web browser to see the login window.

### Downgrading to previous firmware versions

Downgrade to previous versions of FortiManager Cloud is not supported.
