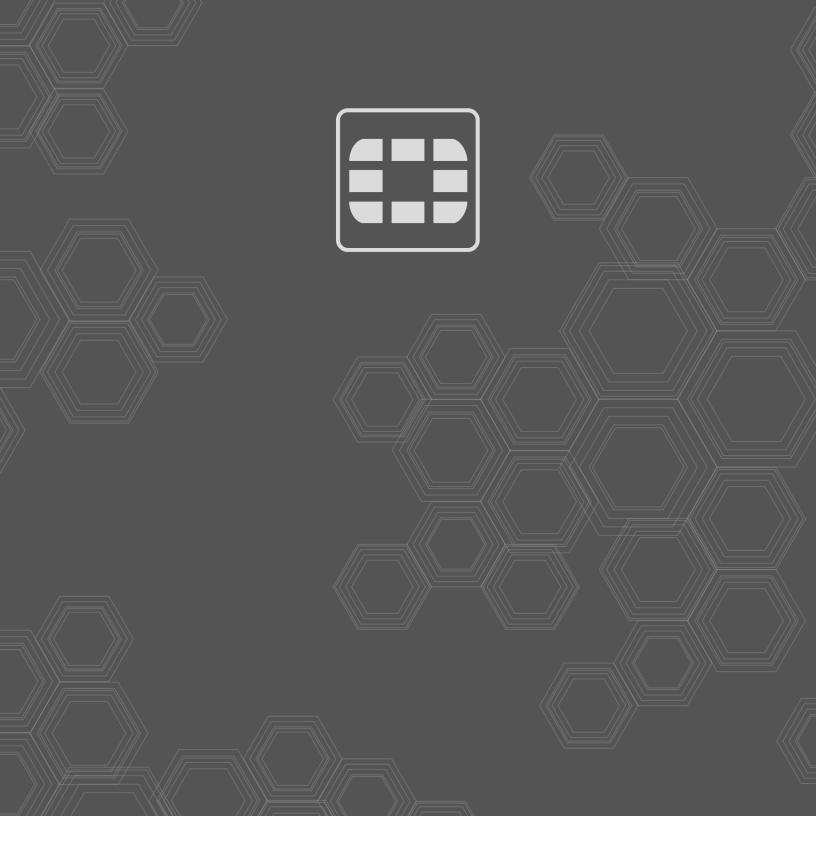
What's new

Bug ID	Description
659880	48 hour grace period is added to continue SIP functionality if HTTP login has failed.
665272	Answering an iOS call while on a softclient call results in no audio when returning to the softclient call.
665716	After an automatic upgrade to version 3.0.13, if softclient has not been opened, an incoming call would crash the softclient.





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
