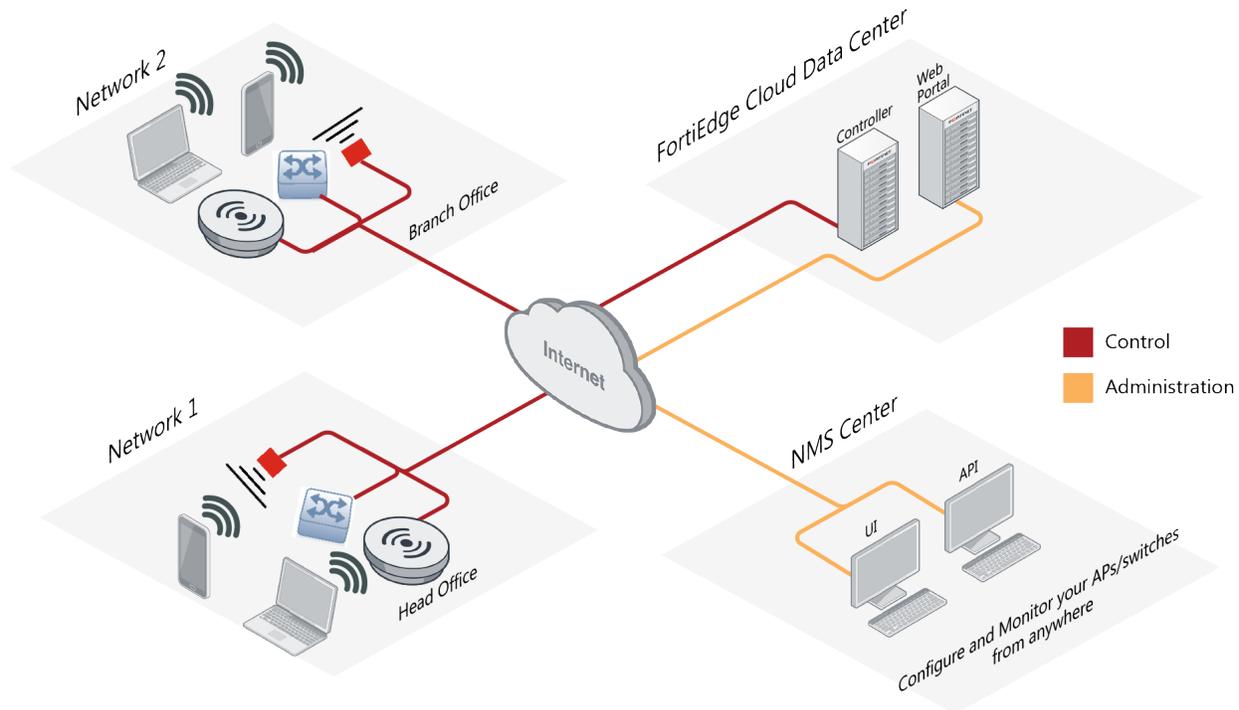


FortiEdge Cloud will no longer support multi-tenancy license extensions after December 31, 2026. Any multi-tenancy license extended will have its expiration date set to December 31, 2026, regardless of the start date.

What is FortiEdge Cloud

FortiEdge Cloud is a unified management platform for standalone FortiAP, FortiSwitch, and FortiExtender deployments. It provides configuration management and monitoring control for a handful of devices and can scale up to thousands of devices across multiple sites.

Device Support	<p>This release of FortiEdge Cloud now supports the following devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FortiExtender<ul style="list-style-type: none">• FEX-101G• FEX-211G
eSIM Support	<p>The FortiExtender 211G series now supports eSIMs for cellular connectivity.</p> <p>FortiEdge Cloud GUI provides the initial step for provisioning the eSIMs. Enable the appropriate standard SIM slot (SIM1 or SIM2) in the FortiEdge Cloud Modem Settings (Extender > Profile > Modem1 Settings). Enabling the SIM here activates the corresponding eSIM slot on the device.</p> <p>Note: This cloud configuration is only the first step. You must log into the FortiExtender GUI to perform the remaining steps required to fully provision and activate the eSIM profile. For more information, see FortiExtender Admin Guide (Standalone).</p>

Resolved issues

Issue ID	Description
1203447	After FortiGuest self-registration and credential submission, some users succeed while the login page hangs for others.
1202390	Upgrades initiated from FortiEdge Cloud fail for all the switch models.
1201260	Certificates pushed from FortiEdge Cloud for signature based VPN appear as <code>Unknown</code> on the FortiExtender, preventing tunnel establishment, while the same certificates manually uploaded using the device GUI work correctly.

Known issues

Issue ID	Description
1219514	The PoE and USB configured and operating values does not match the actual AP wireless configuration output.

Additional Notes

Note the following while using FortiEdge Cloud:

- For faster GUI and API responses, Fortinet recommends deploying a total of less than 2000 switches and FortiAPs in a network. Also, the number of switch ports should be less than 15000.
- The upgrade process completion takes approximately 30 minutes if you try to upgrade multiple FortiAPs (count in 3 digits or more) simultaneously.
